As articulated in the Corporate Safety Policy Statement on Health, Safety and the Environment, Trican supports the Industry Guiding Principles of Worker Safety, which states:

As Corporate members of the Petroleum Industry, we have a responsibility to protect the environment, members of society and all workers engaged in our activities from personal injury and health hazards. To meet our responsibility we will operate under the following guiding principles:

RESPONSIBILITY

Trican, when acting as the prime contractor, is responsible for coordination and general supervision of all activities at the work site, including activities carried out by contractors, subcontractors and suppliers. While all parties have a responsibility to promote worker safety, Trican recognizes its leadership role in promoting workers health and safety on the basis that it has the greatest power to influence work site situations. It is the responsibility of employees and employers to refuse to perform unsafe work.

PRIORITY

All activities will be conducted on the basis that the safety of all personnel is of vital importance, whether those personnel are employed by Trican, a contractor, a subcontractor or a supplier.

RECOGNITION

The process of selecting contractors, subcontractors and suppliers, and the administration of contracts, will include recognition and support of good safety performance.

IMPROVEMENT

Trican, in cooperation with others within the industry, will promote methods and practices that have the potential for improving safety performance.
